02 – PLACE AND DATE OF RACES

the races will take place on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd of August in the waters in front of the Club

03 - RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 – 2020 and Italian national authority, FIV regulation for sport sailing activity 2019, including his prescriptions that are to be considered "Rule"; from this Notice of Race, from the Race Instruction. and by the Official Announcements that will be exposed to the Official Notice Board. In the event of a conflict between these, will be valid the Race Instruction and Official Announcements (Changes to RRS 73.3)

for all Classes, add to rule 61.1 (a): "The Protestant boat must notify the Race Committee immediately after arrival of the intention to protest and the identity of the boat (s) she intends to protest.

It will be the Competitor's responsibility to ensure that his intention to protest has been acknowledged by the Race Committee..

04 - ADVERTISING

advertising is permitted in compliance with the FJ class regulations. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen by the organization authority (Regulation 20 W.S.).

Italian competitors that display advertising need to have a valid FIV licence. they will have to show it at registration.

05 - ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to boats of Flying Junior International Class. All Italian competitors shall be FIV members and have a valid medical certificate, they must have valid class card. Each participating boat shall be insured with a minimum cover of 1.500.000 € per incident or the equivalent. Foreign competitors must be in compliance with the requirements of the National Authority of belonging and with what is prescribed by the Class Association. In accordance with RRS G1.1 (c), competitors may use personal sailing numbers assigned by National Class Association.

Competitors under the age of 18 must submit the registration form signed at the bottom by the parent, guardian or support person who act in accordance with rule 3.1 (b) and who, during the event, takes responsibility for letting it go into the water to race.

Required fees is € 125,00 for each boats.

Teams from abroad who will participate to the World championship 2019 in Porto San Giorgio, will gain a 20% discount on the entry fee of the Italian championship. To take advantage of the discount must pre-register and pay the registration fee at the same time of payment fee for the World Championship.

No boats will be allowed to take off from a different location than the Organizing Committee.

The pre-registration on the website www.circoloacquafresca.it is compulsory before July 21st 2019.

The non-pre-registration before Sunday, July 21st increases the registration fee of € 50.00.

Registration must be completed strictly before 11:30 am on Thursday, August 1st at the Organizing Committee office with the following opening hours: 10.00-12.30 13.30-17.00

06 - SCHEDULE

Nine races are scheduled. More than 3 (three) races per day can not be disputed.

The Championship will be valid if at least 3 (three) races are completed.

The scheduled time for the warning signals for the first race is 12:00 a.m. of Thursday 1st of august. The time of warning signal for the first race for the days after the first will be communicate to the Race Comity before 07:00 p.m. of the previous day.

Saturday 3rd of august, no warning signals will be made after 04:30 p.m.

The crews registered in the championship will use the facilities of the Club from Sunday 28 July.

07 - MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurements certificate. the sails must already be measured and they will be stamped at the registration time.

It will be possible to measure and stamp two main sail, two jib and two spinnaker for each boat.

No preventive measurement checks are planned but The Race Committee or Jury may subject boats to random measurement checks. Competitors must compete with boats, equipment and sails regularly measured and can not replace any sail or damaged equipment, with other regularly measured, without written permission of the Technical Committee or the Race Committee.

08 – SAIL ISTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at registration.

09 – COURSES AND SCORING

The courses will be defined in the sailing instructions.

The Minimum Score System described in Appendix A of RRS will be adepte. When fewer than four races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races score excluding her worst score. When nine races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.

For the awarding the Regatta will be valid with only one race disputed.

10 - SUPPORT STAFF BOATS

All support persons must register by completing the registration form available at the Regatta Secretariat stating:

- the characteristics of boats;
- the acceptance of the "Rules for Support Staff Boats" described in the Sailing Instructions;
- the names of the accompanying Competitors.

Support persons must be equipped with marine VHF radio and be tuned to the frequency of assistance boats, in the event of an emergency they will have to collaborate with rescue boats and help boats in difficulty. will receive a mark, from the Regatta's Secretariat, to be shown in evidence on the vehicle (a returnable security deposit of 20 euros will be requested for the flag).

Accredited support personnel will be subject to the technical and disciplinary directives of the Race committee and of the Jury who will also be able to revoke the permit to be present on the race course or act in accordance with RRS 64.4.

11 - RADIOCOMUNICATIONS

A boat racing shall not make voice or data transmission and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This provision also applies to the use of mobile phones, smartphone and tablet .



12 - PRIZES

The first five will be awarded. The first junior crew will be awarded; in absence of crew entirely juniors will be awarded the crew with a least one juniors member.

For the attribution of the title of Italian champion a separate classification will be drawn up for the completely Italian crews; the first 3 of this ranking will be awarded

13 - LIABILITY

19.1 As per Fundamental Rule 4, the competitors participants take part in the race under their full and exclusive responsibility. The Competitors and their Supporters are solely responsible for the decision to take part or to continue the race. The Organizing Committee, the Race Committee, the Technical Committee, where present, the Jury and those who for whatever reason take part in organizing the event, decline any and all responsibility for damages that may be incurred by persons and/or things, both on the ground that in water, as a result of their participation in the Regatta referred to this Notice of Race. Competitors and their supporters decide on the basis of their skills, wind force, sea conditions, weather forecasts and anything else that must be expected of a good sailor, if they go out to sea and participate to the regatta, to continue it or to renounce it.

14 - MEDIA RIGHTS

By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
