



GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE FJ CLASS YOUTH TECHNICAL MEETING

21-22-23 JULY 2023, BRENZONE SUL GARDA, ITALY

- 1) The national association of the International FJ sailing class organizes a youth technical meeting (FJYM), with the aim of improving the competitive performance of the participants through training in the water and insights in the classroom. The activity will be aimed at improving racing performance. Participation is limited to 16 sailors on the basis of what is reported in point 9. The organization will be able to remodulate the Meeting in case of redundant registrations.
- 2) The meeting will take place at the Acquafresca Sport Center in Brenzone sul Garda, which will host the FJ Class European Championship in the days following the Meeting.
- 3) During the three days of the Meeting, the participants will be involved throughout the day depending on the weather conditions and the required and necessary insights.
- 4) The technical didactic activity of the Meeting is coordinated by federal coaches.
- 5) Each participant must be in good standing with their national sailing authority and have a Civil Liability Policy with a ceiling of at least 1,500,000 euros
- 6) Each participant must have a FJ suitably equipped for racing. In any case, registrations from those who do not have a boat will also be accepted with reserve.
- 7) By signing these general conditions, each boat owner declares that the boat made available is efficient and safe.
- 8) Entries are individual. The coaches, having read the list of participants and after the opening briefing, will organize the crews. However, it will be possible to ask not to separate the already established crews. In order to maximize the usefulness of the training in their opinion, the coaches will be able to recommend rotations in the crews and in the roles.
- 9) **PARTICIPATION FEES - MAXIMUM 16 PARTICIPANTS:**
Sailors younger than 22 – no participation fee
Sailors between 22 and 30 – €100
Sailors older than 30 – €100
- 10) **REGISTRATION:** young sailors have priority in registration. Older sailors may apply but they will be registered later. Registration opens: 15 February 2023, sailors older than 22 will be placed on the waiting list. Free registration for young sailors closes: 1 June 2023. After 1 June 2023, sailor between 22 and 30 years of age will be enrolled following the waiting list. If at the end of this step there are still available spots, sailors older than 30 will be enrolled based on their position in the waiting list.
The number of participants may be increased in case of strong demand for participation.
- 11) The FJ class is not responsible for any damage to people or things that may occur during the meeting. Each participant will decide whether to go into the water and whether to make the boat available in relation to their preparation and the current weather conditions.
